- Selon ce que vous en savez, comment la vie familiale, en France ou ailleurs dans le monde francophone, est-elle en train de changer ?



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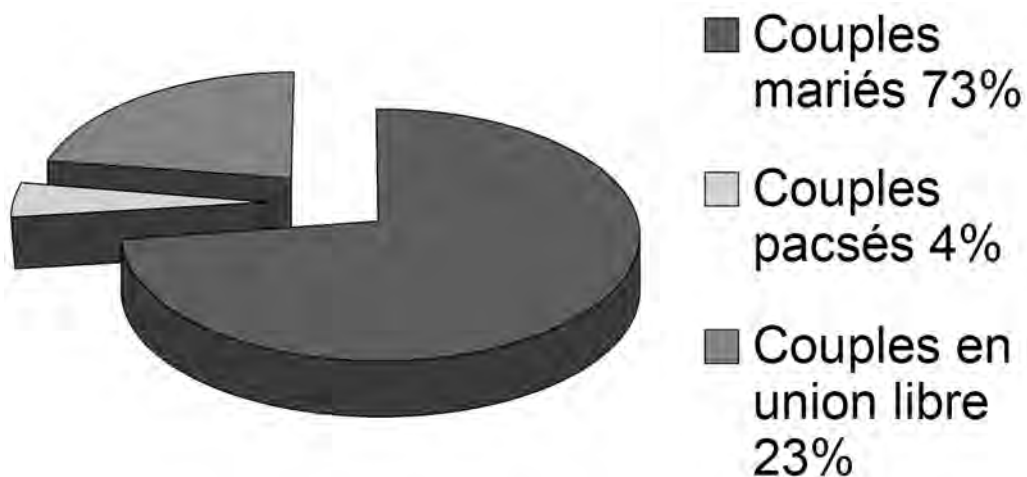

En France, deux adultes sur trois sont en couple, dont 73% mariés, 4% pacsés et 23% en union libre. Deux autres tendances à noter : les unions sont moins durables qu'autrefois et la naissance du premier enfant a lieu de plus en plus tard.

D'après une étude récente, 45% des internautes consultent régulièrement un des 14 millions de blogs publiés chaque année. Le blogueur typique est un homme de moins de 30 ans habitant dans une grande ville d'une des communautés francophones. Les blogueurs disent que la motivation principale de bloguer est de se faire plaisir (65%) et de partager des connaissances (63%).

Avec 7 millions de victimes en 12 mois, la France se place dans les dix pays où la cybercriminalité est la plus active. Les raisons ? Moins de 23% installent un logiciel de sécurité sur leurs portables. En plus, 53% des Français ne se déconnectent pas à la fin d'une session sur les réseaux sociaux, 39% partagent leurs mots de passe avec une autre personne et, pire encore, 43% entrent en contact avec des inconnus.

Instructions

- During the 15 minutes preparation time, you are required to prepare two stimulus cards. You will be asked to choose your first card from two on one sub-theme and then you must choose one of the other two cards the examiner gives you.
- You may make notes during the preparation time only on the Additional Answer Sheet provided. **You must not write on the cards.**
- You should take the stimulus cards with you into the examination room. You may refer to the cards and any notes you have made at any time during the test.
- You should hand the stimulus cards and the Additional Answer Sheet to the examiner at the end of the test.

Information

- The test will last between 12 and 14 minutes and will consist of **two** stimulus cards (6-7 minutes each).
- The examiner will ask the questions exactly as they are printed on the cards and may ask follow-up questions to develop the discussion of the sub-themes.
- You must ask the examiner one question arising from the material on each card. You can ask the question at any time during the discussion of the card.
- To develop the discussion of the sub-themes, you will be expected to respond to questions and discuss in **French** broader issues within the sub-themes on the cards.
- You must **not** use a dictionary at any time during this test. This includes the preparation time.
