

(c) You met one of your former teachers whom you had not seen for several years. Compose the dialogue that took place between the two of you.

(a) Write a story which begins as follows: "It was ten o'clock at night, and everyone was asleep..."

(c) In the market when you wanted to pay for your goods, you realised that you had lost your purse. Narrate what happened.

(d) Some people consider that eating "fast food" is bad for your health. What is your opinion?
