- (b) Explain why the Roman occupation and government at the time of Jesus caused conflict. [6]

- 2 (a) Outline the temptations of Jesus in the wilderness. [6]
- (b) Explain why it might be significant that the temptations took place before Jesus began his ministry. [6]
- (c) 'The childhood and early life of Jesus are not important to the gospel story.'

- 3 (a) Give an account of the occasion when Jesus healed the paralytic. [6]
- (b) Explain what this miracle might show about the person and work of Jesus. [6]

- 4 (a) Give an account of what happened on the mountain at the Transfiguration. [6]
- (b) Explain what the Transfiguration might teach about the person of Jesus. [6]
