- a. How do Muslims prepare for prayers? [10] or
- a. What are the conditions required for prayer? [10]
  - Salat is an obligatory worship which is performed by adult Muslims five times a day
  - It is the <u>second pillar</u> of Islam
  - Following rules must be followed before starting it
  - The first rule is to purify from all impurities. (Najasat)
  - "Allah does not accept prayer without purification" (Hadith). Thus, there should be no impurity on our bodies, dresses or on places before we start prayers
  - <u>Urine, blood and wine</u> all are impure so if they are found on clothes, place or body then they must be cleaned.
  - If <u>dog licks a clothe</u> then it must be washed seven times. Also, intoxicated people should not go for prayer. "And do not approach to the prayer when you are intoxicated" (Quran)
  - <u>Wudu</u> is the basic condition for prayers. Its obligatory acts are mentioned in Quran: "
    O you who believe when you stand up for prayer then wash your faces and hands till elbows; Rub your heads with wet hands and wash your feet till the ankles"
  - According to this verse washing face and hands till elbows, masah of head and washing feet are obligatory acts without which prayer must not be offered.
  - Wash both hands up to wrists 3 times.
  - Gargle 3 times.
  - Sniff in water in nostril using right hand, use left hand to clean nose.
  - Wash the face thrice completely
  - Wash the right and then the left arm up to the elbows thrice.
  - Perform masah by wiping hand on one fourth of the head
  - Both ears are cleansed inside and outside with index finger and the thumb
  - the back of the two hands are passed on the nape of the neck.
  - The right & left feet are washed up to the ankles thrice
  - <u>Satar</u>, covering private parts of body is a must requirement.
  - The body should be covered properly
  - Muslims must offer their prayers at the prescribed times
  - "Verily prayer has been made obligatory for the believers at its fixed time" (Quran)
  - There are fixed timings for every prayer from fajar to isha
  - However, Prayers should not be offered when the Sun rising, it is at the top and when it is setting
  - All prayers are offered while <u>directing towards Qibla</u>, Kabah at Makkah.
  - "So turn your face toward al-Masjid al-Haram. And wherever you are, turn your faces
    toward it [in prayer]." ( Quran). So it is obligatory to turn face towards Kaba in every
    prayer.
  - For each of the time and kind of prayer, one has to make intention before starting prayers
