- (a) What is the name of the special place in a synagogue where the Torah scrolls are kept? [1]
- (b) State **three** ways in which Jews show respect to the Torah scrolls when they are handling them. [3]
- (c) Explain why the Torah is important for Jews. [6]

- (a) Describe how Christians might celebrate Easter. [12]
- (b) Explain why Easter is an important festival for Christians. [12]

5 ISLAM

- (a) Describe how the Qur'an is used by Muslims in their daily lives. [12]
- (b) Explain why the Qur'an is important for Muslims. [12]

6 JUDAISM

- (a) Describe places a Jew might visit on a pilgrimage to Israel. [12]

- 7 (a) Describe **two** of the different groups within Judaism, and **two** of the different groups within Christianity. [12]
- (b) Explain why **both** Judaism **and** Christianity have become divided into different groups. [12]
- 8 (a) For **both** Judaism **and** Islam, describe a festival when special food might be eaten for religious reasons. [12]
- (b) Explain why these festivals and their special foods are important for Jews **and** for Muslims. [12]
