- 4 Design a repeat pattern based on car parts.
- 5 Using a calligraphic script with which you are familiar, write out all or part of the following extract:

He was in awe and afraid. There were riches to the right, treasures to the left and goodies right before him. He had just one obstacle to negotiate. The keeper of the money. Well, this was his first trip alone to the local sweet shop and after all, he was only eight.
