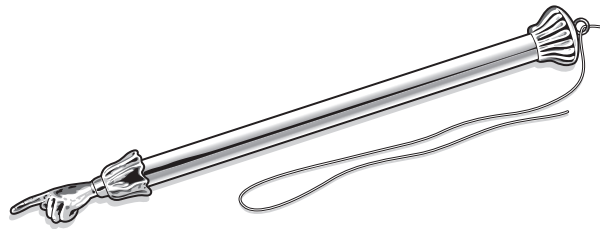
## Section C – Judaism
