Pedestrian counts at three locations within different zones of the Central Business District (CBD) of a major UK city for a 24-hour period in June 2019






Online purchases, by type and age group, for May, June and July 2019 in Great Britain




Concentrations of microplastic particles in the water of the River Tame, UK, 2019



Concentrations of microplastic particles, by type, in channel bed sediments in the River Tame, UK, 2019



