- 2 (a) Analyse the importance and significance of rights of passage, with particular reference to birth and death rituals. [30]

- 3 (a) Outline and examine the events which led to the split between Sunni and Shia Islam. [30]
- (b) Critically evaluate the claim that Sunni and Shia Islam are so different that they appear to be different religions. [20]
- 4 (a) Analyse and discuss the importance of Islamic teaching on Angels and Prophets (Risalah). [30]
- (b) Critically assess the view that a single correct interpretation of the Qur'an is not possible. [20]
