- 3 (a) Analyse and discuss the content of Muirchú's **Life of Patrick**. [30]

- (b) Critically evaluate the claim that hagiographical writings have no historical value. [20]

- 4 (a) "Missionary activity was a significant feature of the Celtic Church."

Examine this statement with particular reference to the work of Gall, Killian and the Burgh Castle group. [30]

- (b) Critically assess the view that the love of adventure was the only motive for peregrinatio. [20]
