### **Source A**

#### **Democracy and Inclusion in Northern Ireland**

The Good Friday Agreement outlines actions to be taken to bring peace to Northern Ireland. One of the features of the Agreement included the setting up of a devolved government in Northern Ireland.

The Good Friday Agreement supports democracy in Northern Ireland. The main features of a democracy include people having human rights and having the right to elect a government.

Local communities may include people from a diversity of groups. These may include people from ethnic minority groups, religious groups and the Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual and Transgender (LGBT) community.

Local communities can help to ensure that everyone feels part of the community by promoting inclusion. One way they can do this is by setting up a community group. Inclusion is important because it will help to ensure people in minority groups do not feel marginalised or excluded.
