## editor's letter

# She's incredible...

Working on a bi-monthly, there aren't many occasions when we find ourselves at the mercy of a breaking story. But for this issue, with an in-depth profile of US news anchor Megyn Kelly in the features lineup, we were keen to hold the presses until the American presidential election result was in. Kelly, the face of Fox News, was the first person to publicly take Trump to task over his attitude to women, and this election period has seen her emerge as one of the most powerful voices in the American media. PORTER's features director Vassi Chamberlain caught up with the mother of three to discuss her tussle with Trump, the price of success and how she keeps herself and her family grounded.

2016 seems to have been a year when many prominent women found their voices in a very modern, personal way – sometimes purely by just being the best in the world at what they do. Inspired by this, our second Incredible Women list features our top 10 female voices of the year, starting with Beyoncé, whose staggering album *Lemonade* was as much about an ongoing African-American struggle as it was her own story as a black woman. Similarly, whether it was Michelle Obama denouncing 'locker room' misogyny or Sheryl Sandberg urging resilience in her grief, these 'voices' inspire us by speaking for women everywhere. And never more so than in four original letters written for PORTER by Serena Williams, Amber Heard, Simone Biles and Sharon Horgan, which I think pack quite a punch.

One common problem voiced by many in the issue is the challenge of managing the different elements of our lives. For Kelly, family and career have always taken priority over her social life – which is also the case for our cover star, actress Michelle Williams, who manages a high-profile acting career with being a single parent. Indeed, towards the end of the shoot in Long Island, a few of us, all working mothers with very different professions and lives, found ourselves sitting together as the sun went down, talking about choices – what we have to sacrifice and how we find time for ourselves.

Finally, having just returned from a much-needed week away with my family in Marrakesh, where I carved out a few hours each day to go to the gym and spa, I realized the importance not only of finding time to press reset on one's own health and fitness, but also of escaping the whirlwind of daily life to clear some head space. I hope that the issue's spa guide serves as a similar – and useful – reminder that, whatever else is going on in your world, taking time out to look after yourself is always the right choice.
