- 5 say where you would like to take some friends for a walk or
other outdoor activity, what you would do there and why.**

- 2 give details of when and how often you contact friends and family;**
- 3 give details of your communications online about a party that you recently went to, or plan to go to, and say how you feel about them;**
- 4 say whether or not you think that people take enough care when they socialise online and why;**
- 5 say what you would do to persuade your friends to spend more time together than on the Internet and why.**

living in Turkey, or any Turkish-speaking country, and why;**
