Translation:

‘The king of the Ethiopians advises the king of the Persians to march against the long-lived Ethiopians only when the Persians can draw bows of such size as easily as this; and until then to thank the gods who do not put it into the Ethiopians’ minds to acquire another land in addition to their own.’
