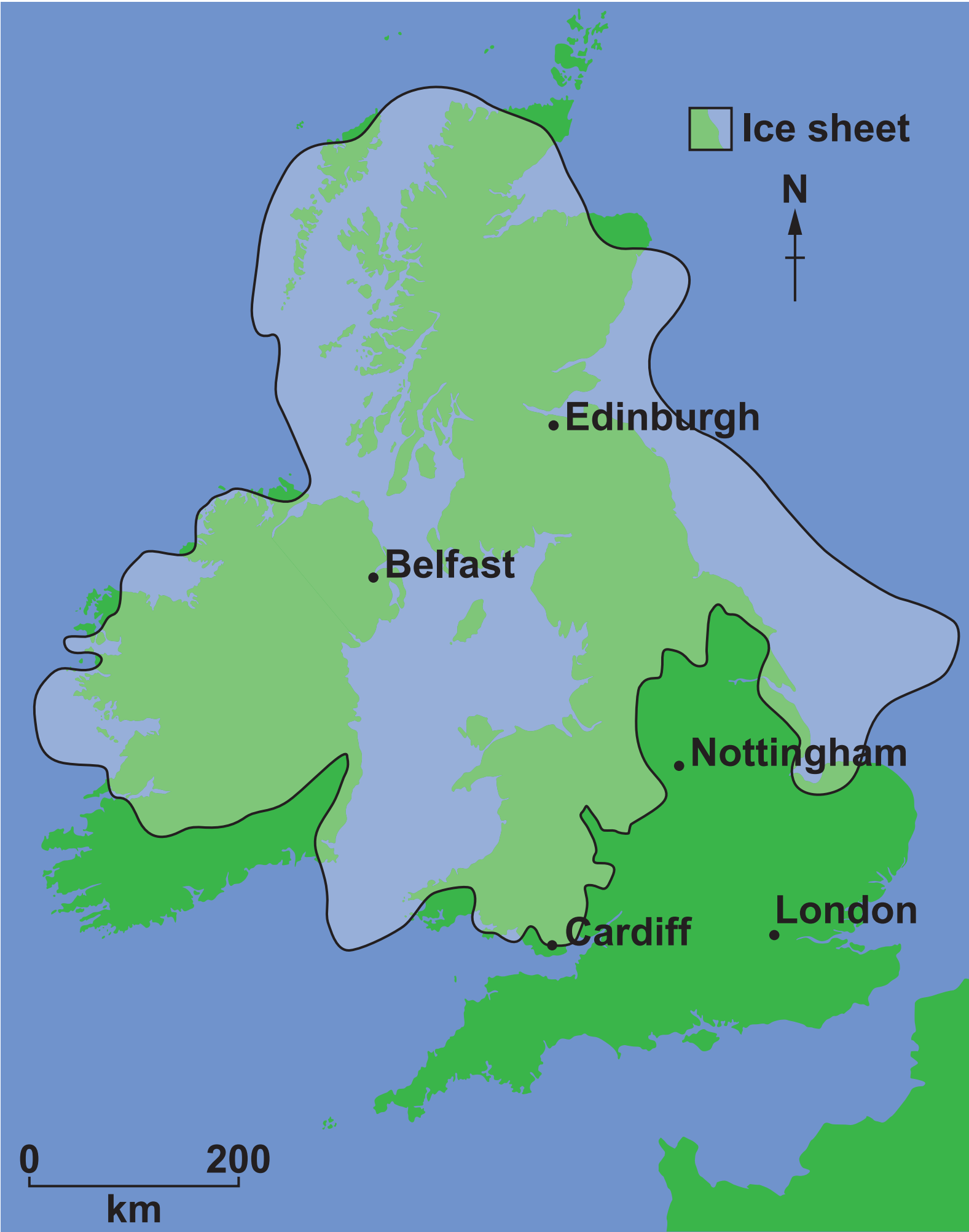
**Fig. 2 – Photograph of Blakeney Point spit**

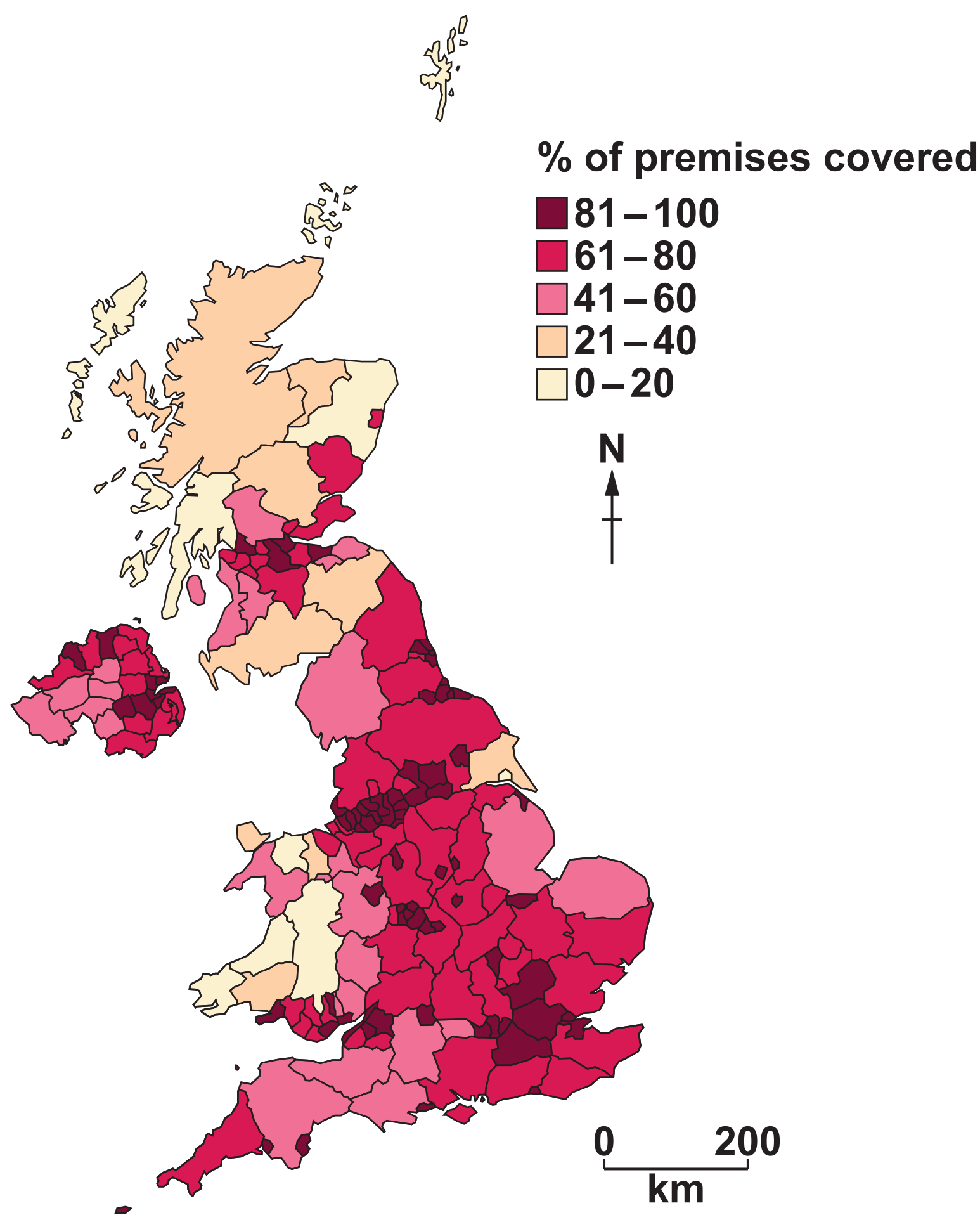
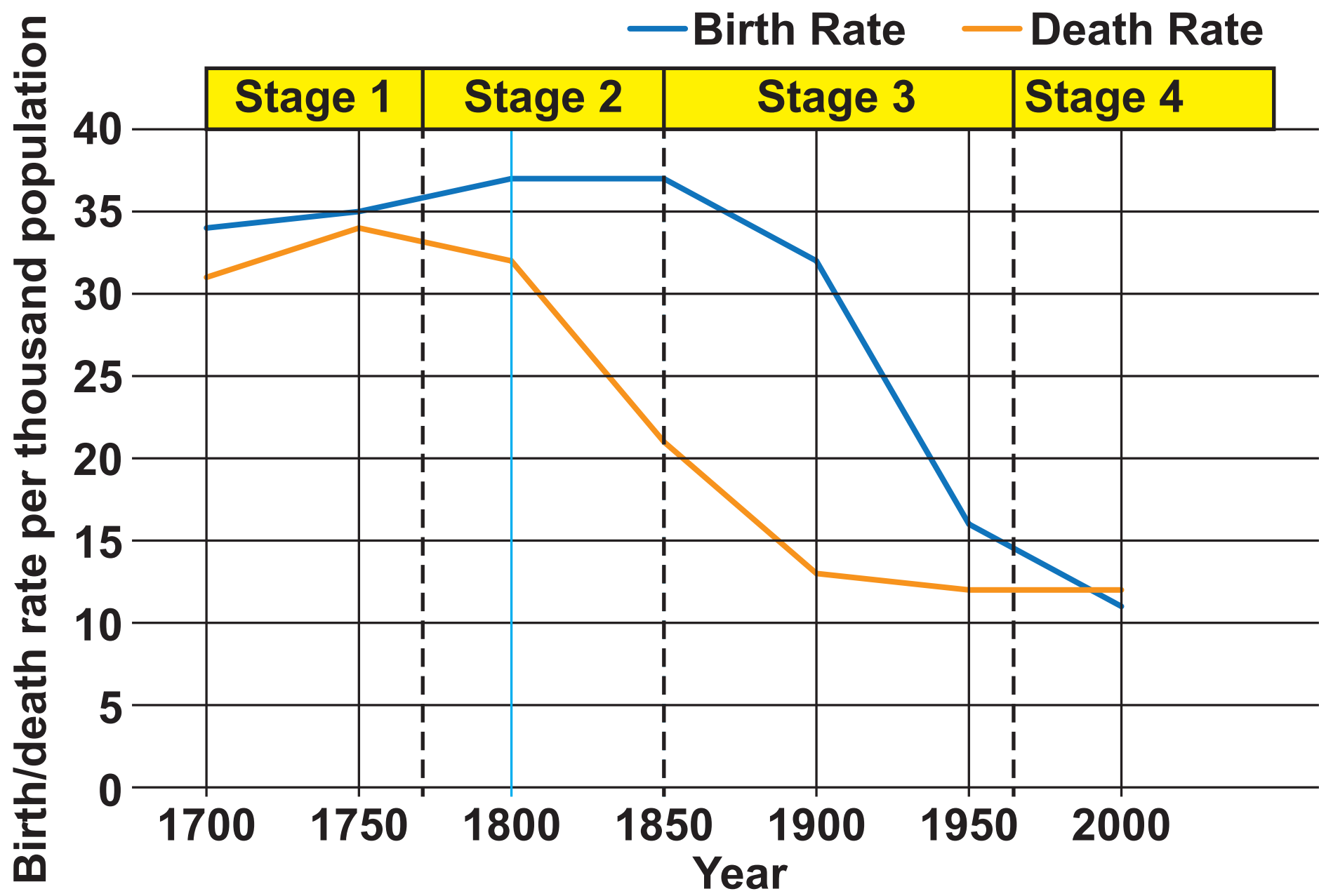


Fig. 4 – Demographic transition in the UK
