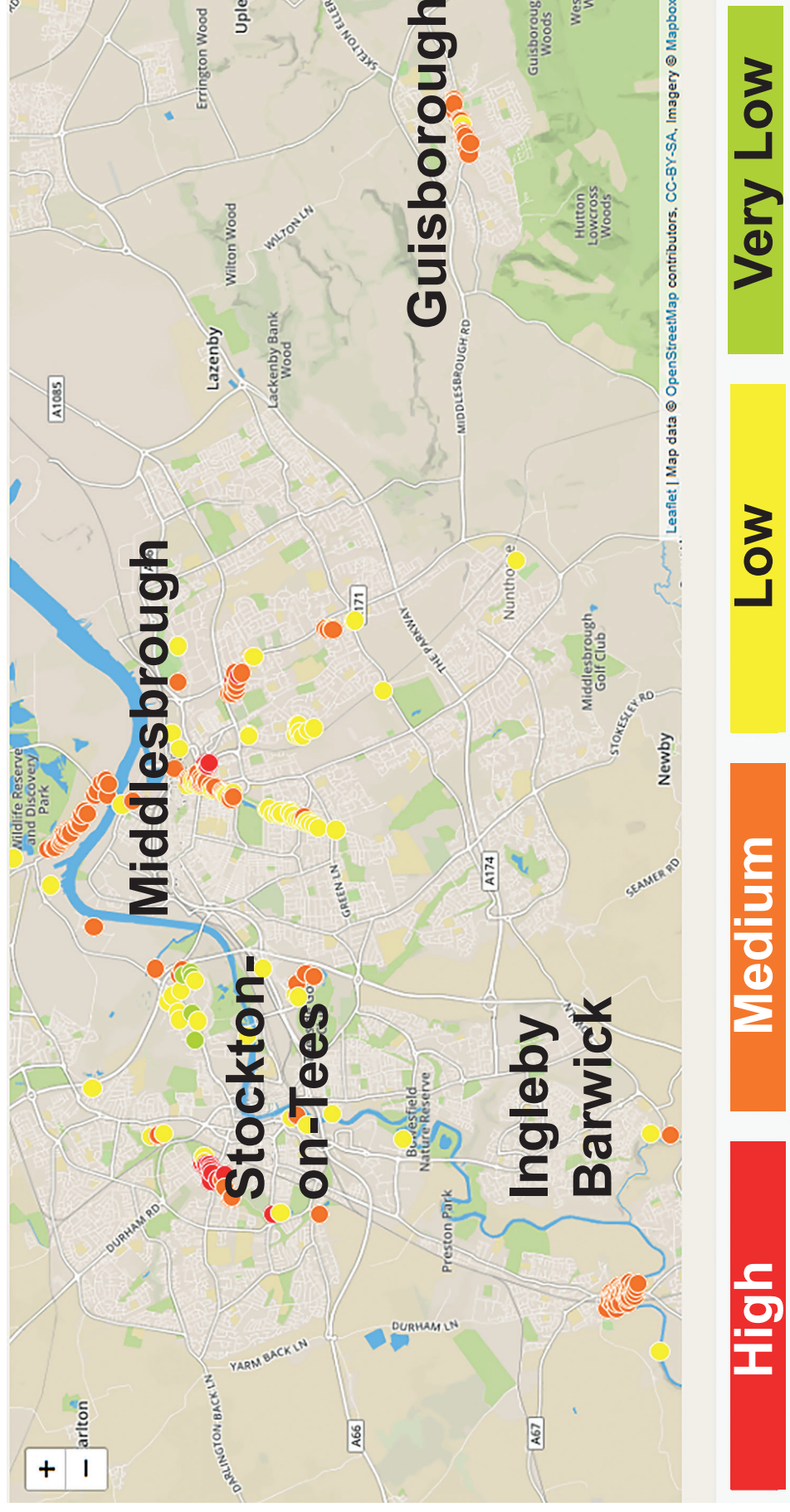

FIG. 3 – The direction and volume of buses per day to the village of Skinningrove

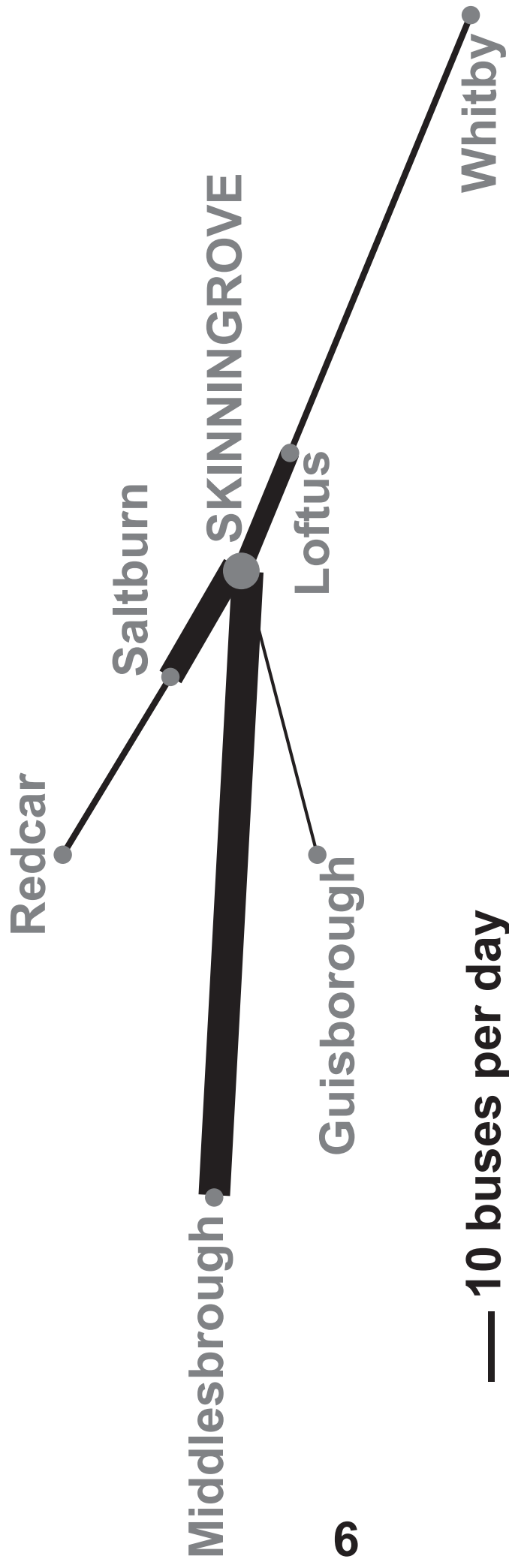


FIG. 4 – Average age of rural and urban UK populations, 2002–2016

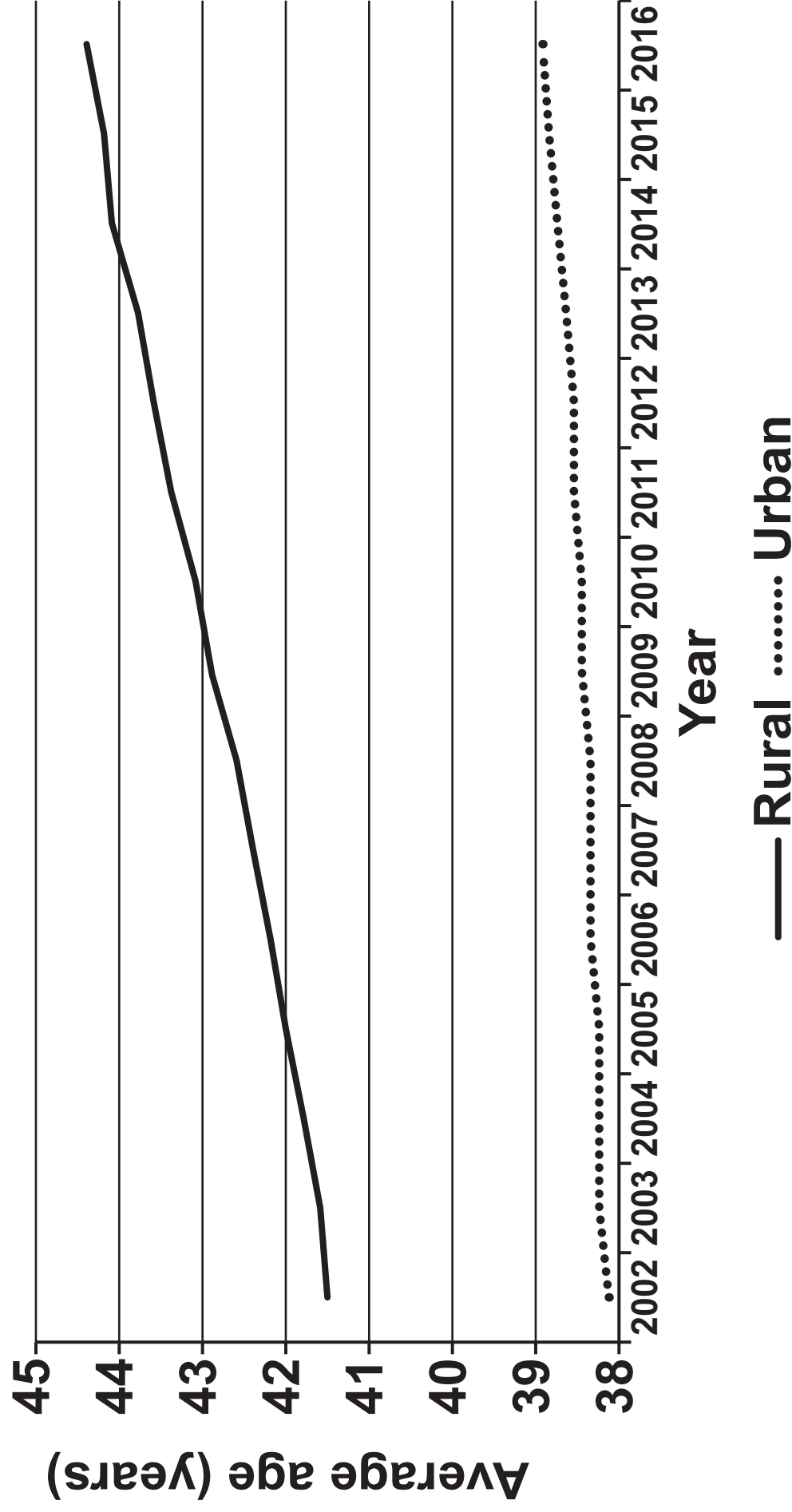
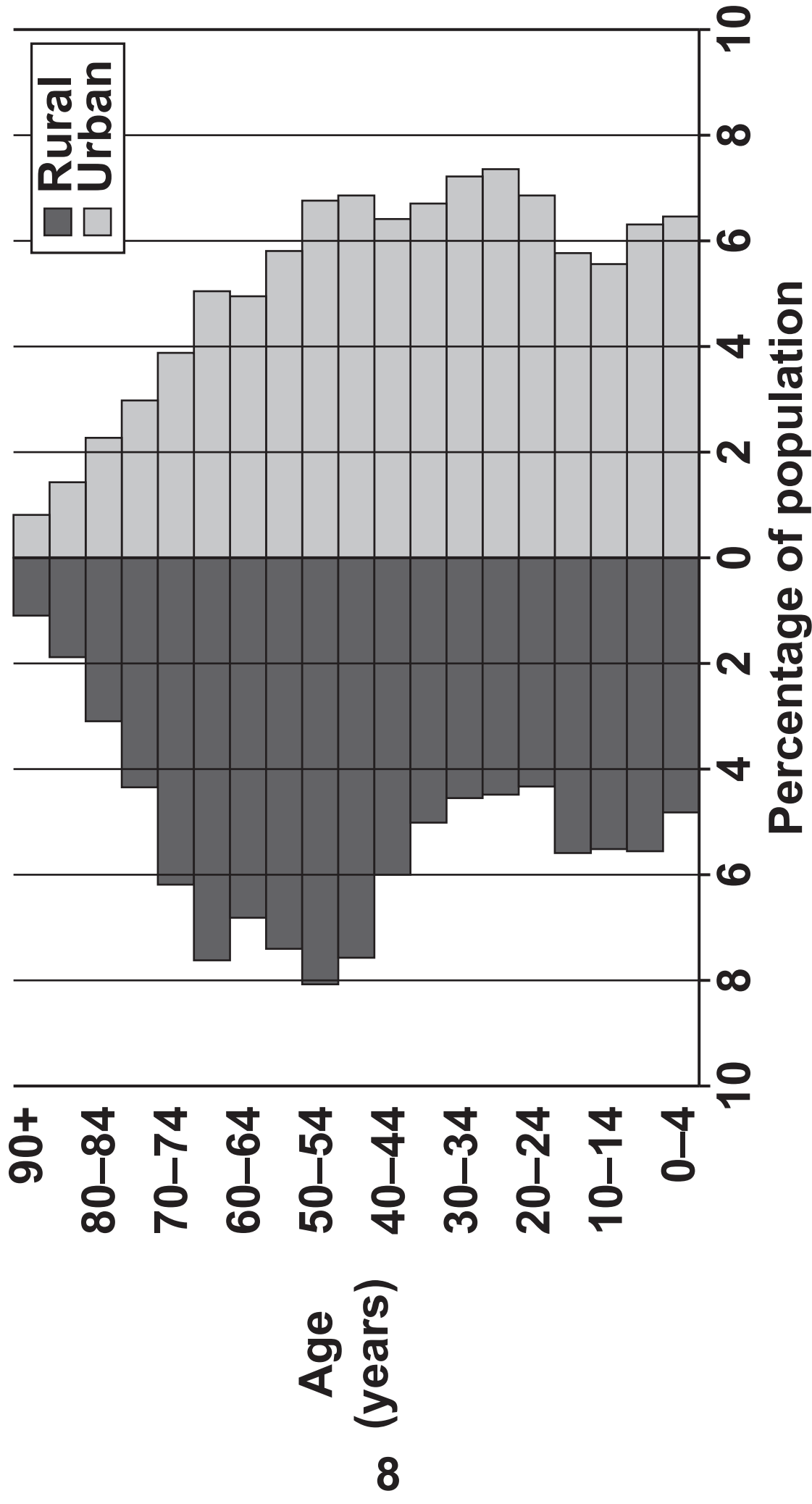


FIG. 5 – Age structure of UK urban and rural populations

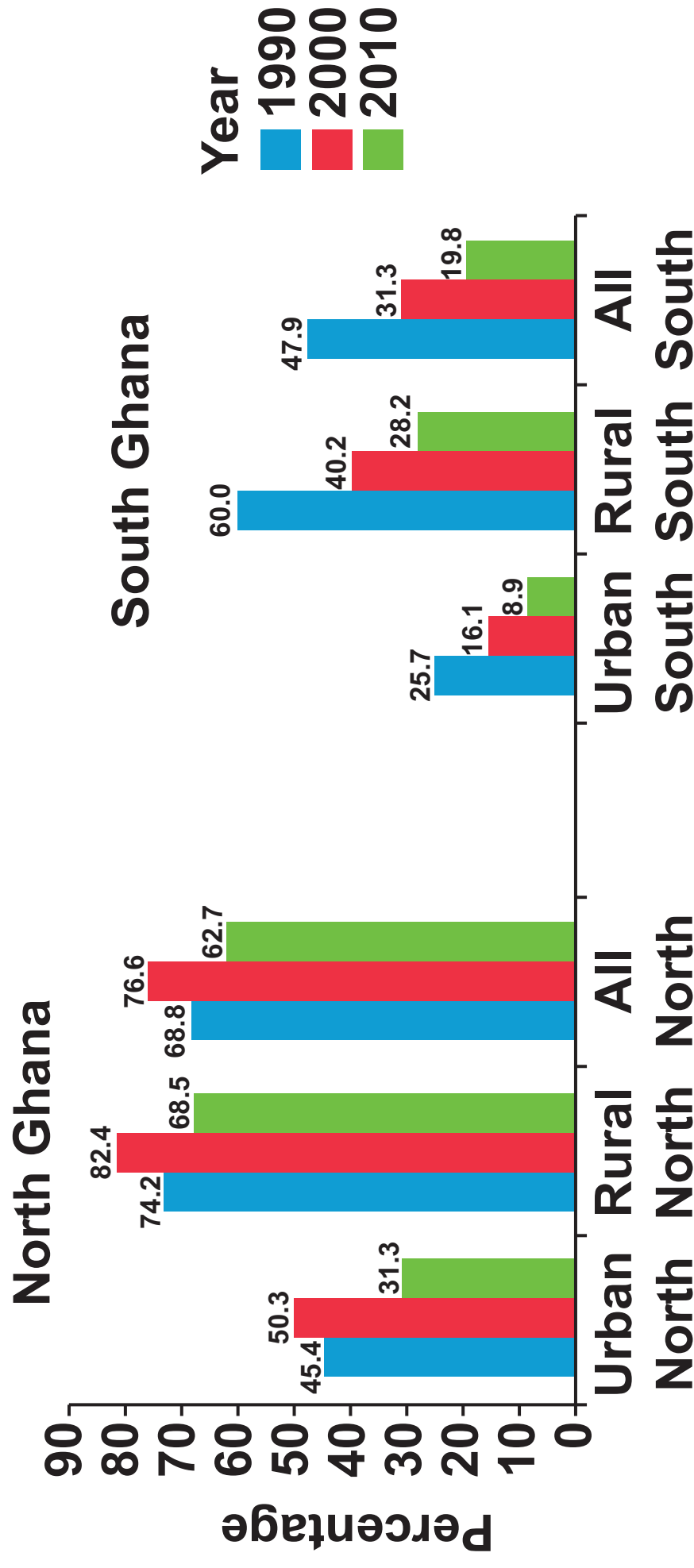

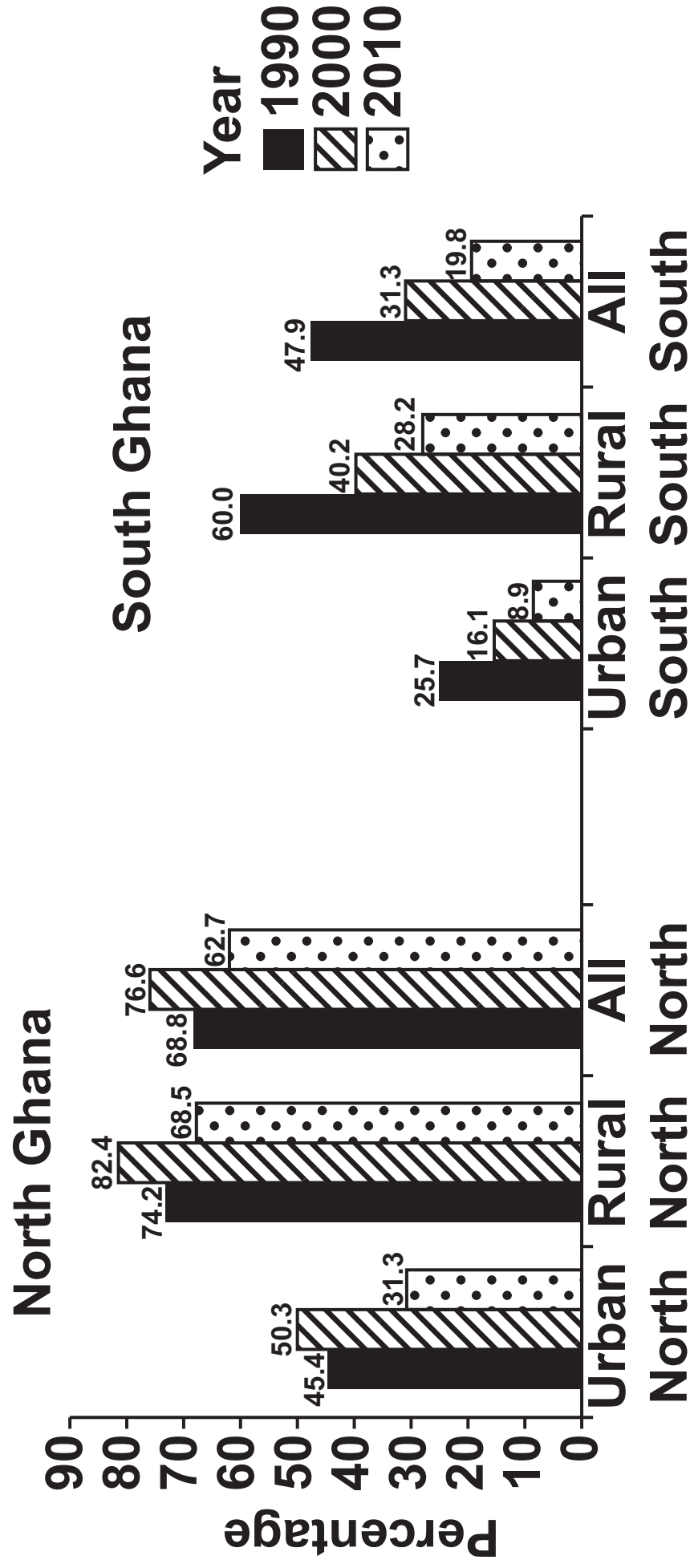


FIG. 8 – Photograph of Middlesbrough city centre
